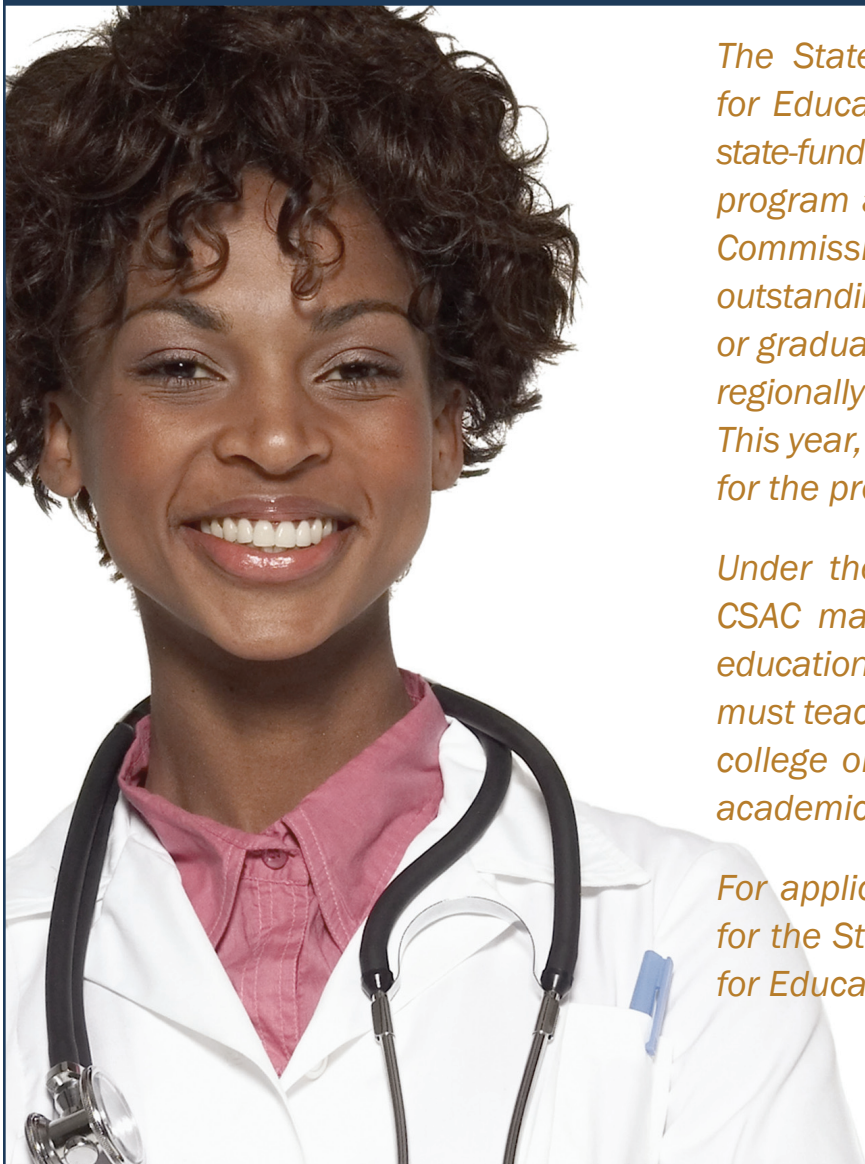

STATE NURSING ASSUMPTION PROGRAM OF LOANS FOR EDUCATION



The State Nursing Assumption Program of Loans for Education for Nursing Faculty (SNAPLE NF) is a state-funded, competitive nursing educator incentive program administered by the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC). It is designed to encourage outstanding students to complete their baccalaureate or graduate degree and serve as nursing faculty at a regionally accredited college or university in California. This year, CSAC will select up to 100 new participants for the program.

Under the provisions of the SNAPLE NF program, CSAC may assume up to \$25,000 of outstanding educational loan balances. To be eligible, participants must teach nursing studies at a regionally accredited college or university in California for three full-time academic years or the equivalent.
